<b>Name of Division/Office</b>	Classification, Human Rights and Copyright Division (Classification Policy Branch)
<b>Title</b>	Northern Territory Emergency Response – transport of prohibited material through prescribed areas
<b>Description of issue</b>	The <i>Families, Housing, Community Services and Indigenous Affairs and Other Legislation Amendment (Emergency Response Consolidation) Bill 2008</i> proposes to amend the <i>Classification (Publications, Films and Computer Games) Act 1995</i> to introduce new provisions to allow prohibited material to be transported through prescribed areas in the Northern Territory.
<b>Consultation opportunities</b>	On 19 March 2008, the Bill was referred to the Senate Community Affairs Committee for inquiry and report.
